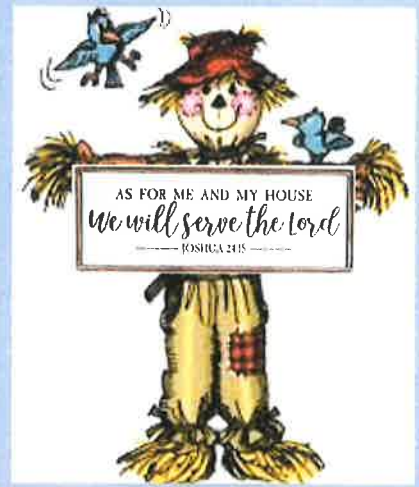
1- Teams who complete challenges at the Pit Stops quickest will make it to the finish line first and of course be sitting in a good position to win the Amazing Race.

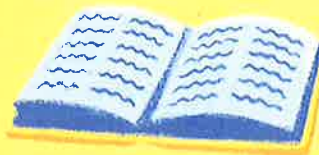

## *From The Nurse*

*PLEASE BE AWARE OF  
OUR UPDATED CCS  
COVID GUIDELINES.*

- 1) If there is a positive COVID case, everyone in the household must quarantine for 10 days per CDC. A doctor's note may extend this period.*
- 2) If someone in the household is tested all members must quarantine pending results.*
- 3) If a student or staff member is vaccinated, with no symptoms, they will not need to quarantine unless a doctor's note says otherwise. Proof of vaccination will be requested.*
- 5) If a vaccinated student or staff member has a symptoms they will be required to quarantine for 10 days or go to the doctor.*
- 6) Home COVID test will be accepted. Results must be provided by pictures.*
