



PLEASE BE AWARE OF OUR UPDATED CCS COVID GUIDELINES.

1) If there is a positive COVID case, everyone in the household must quarantine for 10 days per CDC. A doctor's note may extend this period.

2) If someone in the household is tested all members must quarantine pending results.

3) If a student or staff member is vaccinated, with no symptoms, they will not need to quarantine unless a doctor's note says otherwise. Proof of vaccination will be requested.

5) If a vaccinated student or staff member has a symptoms they will be required to quarantine for 10 days or go to the doctor.

6) Home COVID test will be accepted. Results must be provided by pictures.
